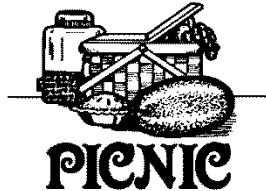
Lillian Preisinger was the National LWML president from 1953-59. She said, "If the women's groups within the church allow themselves to be satisfied with sheer 'activism'
