A big thank you to Marlene Farrell for posting needed items for the Sea Farer Boxes. These boxes will be put together, wrapped, and delivered to the Port to be distributed to the crews on ships from around the world during the Christmas season.

At the convention in Everett last June, there were 16 new grants voted in for a total of \$80,000. They had a good start with the Friday evening offering of \$2,508, and the mite walk brought in \$2,015. Two of the new grants are Aid to Washington-Alaska scholarship Fund and Pastor Parsonage-Soldotna, Alaska. A more detailed list will be forthcoming in the months coming up.

I am writing to encourage you to attend the Didache Divine Service. While it is primarily for the catechumens, all are welcome. I can think of at least 4 reasons to do so. First and foremost, we are taught that we should not despise preaching and His Word but hold it sacred and gladly hear and learn it (explanation of the Third Commandment, Luther's Small Catechism). It is my belief that this applies not only to the Sabbath but anytime we have the opportunity to hear God's word and instruction faithfully preached by our shepherd. Second (and just as important) it is an opportunity to examine ourselves, make confession, and receive absolution in order that we may approach the table and receive the blessing of our Lord's body and blood. Third, I suggest that there is a certain amount of bene+t to the

catechumens to see others from the congregation listening and learning as well -

that is to say, moral support. Finally fourth, there is always something to learn.

Sometimes a subtle nuance of language all the way to the "aha moment" of realization of something I never noticed before.

This is my third time through, and

though I am a "cradle Lutheran," I am amazed and ashamed of how much I don't know.

If any of this has touched your heart (or convicted you in conscience), the current Didache Divine Service is Monday evenings at 6:30 pm. I hope to see you there!


