

In October, Carol Heimbigner delivered 20 quilts to the Lutheran World Relief Ingathering in Hillsboro, OR. Included in the delivery was \$80 to cover shipping. The quilts will be delivered to places in need throughout the world.

Also in 2024 six baby quilts were donated locally to Possibilities. Three baby quilts were given to our congregational babies at their baptisms. The quilters also provided frames for their baptismal certificates.

We went on a field trip in June to the Warm Co. located in Elma. This company manufactures batting and has donated some to our group.

Board of Properties End of Year Update

End of the year already?! First, I'd like to thank my predecessor for taking on this job mostly by himself. I knew there would be a lot involved but I underestimated by 10x. I am still learning! I also want to thank the members of the Board for their selfless devotion to keeping the church running smoothly. Finally, I want to thank the select group of volunteers who do things from lawn mowing to other projects. I know there are others who do things unseen or unnoticed by me, but your Father in heaven sees – and I thank you.

The BoP has undertaken some large projects this year, and other projects to lay the groundwork for future projects. We've removed the current playground which had significant dry rot and will re-install a new set next spring. We've had the furnaces and heat pumps professionally serviced – most are well past their serviceable life and one set is not working. We are waiting for the new coolant systems coming out next year before replacing. Another such project is the installation of security cameras in the parking lot, which should be installed by the time you read this. Many of these are covered by building maintenance savings accounts and specific funds, while general maintenance such as ensuring the exterior lights and emergency systems are working in good order come from the annual budget.

Many of you have let me know of issues around the building, and I appreciate that. Please continue to raise your concerns and I will address them as soon as possible. With that in mind, we do have a need of more volunteers – specifically for lawn care during the growing season. I have a hard and fast rule that no job shall be more than 1 hour, so if it's larger it will be broken up into bite size chunks. Some have tried to work longer and they have been scolded!

Thank you for your patience and support as I learn and grow into your Board of Properties head.


